Q: How do I track books purchased through an online shop?

 Yes. You can track the online book purchases for your book drive. MRP can set up a custom list for your workplace book drive and when someone from your organization accesses the wish list registry, your book drive name will be referenced on the packing slip.

Q: Can I donate money as well as books?

Yes! Donation of funds will go directly towards buying new books we need for the increased giving events during the holiday season. Generally, every \$5 you donate will buy one high-quality book for a kid to love and keep forever.

Q: Why is MRP requesting only new books during the Community Book Drive?

Our Book Center book supply is depleted and we rely on the Community Book Drive to replenish our stock on the shelves to accommodate the increased giving.
