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THE FASHION COMPETITION



Each team will:

- Create a wearable piece of fashion constructed out of at least 90% paper products.
- · Create an outfit worn by a model who will need to walk in it.
- · Create 1 or 2 full pieces of fashion and (optional) one (1) special creation or accessory. (One model per fashion piece.)

Awards will be given out for the following:

- Best in Show
- · Rookie of the Year
- · Most Unique Use of Paper · High Artisanship

Teams:

A team will consist of a team captain, and a designated model. A team can be an individual who will do it all-design, create, and model the final ensemble. Kids are allowed to be on a team and/or be a model. They must be accompanied by an adult at all work sessions and at the final show.)





NOTE: Each registered team will receive two (2) complimentary tickets for the final show. All others will need to purchase a ticket. If you are a corporate sponsored team, please refer to level descriptions for ticket information.
